China's Regulatory System On Outbound Investment: International Treaties

- International Covenant On Economic, Social And Culture Rights(ICESCR)
 - Extra-territory obligations
 - Maastricht principles on extraterritorial obligations of states in the area of economic, social and cultural rights 2011 Committee on economic, social and cultural rights general comment: No. 24 on state obligations under the ICESCR in the context of business activities (July 2017).

"The covenant establishes specific obligations of states parties at three levels -- to respect, to protect and to fulfil. These obligations apply both with respect to situations on the state's national territory, and outside the national territory in situations over which states parties may exercise control"

- UN Guiding Principle of Business and Human Rights 2011: endorsed

"for States and companies to prevent, address and remedy human rights abuses committed in business operations".

Goal Pact Of The Environment Under UNEP 2018

China's Official Statements on Indigenous People

- ILO 169: didn't sign
- UN Declaration Of Indigenous People: supported
 - Although China has no indigenous people, it firmly supports the promotion and protection of the basic rights and freedom of indigenous peoples.
 - China would like to reiterate that currently, there is no international consensus on the definition of "indigenous people", and that not all countries have indigenous people, still less should native residents be equated to indigenous people.
 - The specific arrangements for enhancing the participation of indigenous peoples in UN meetings must be in line with the purposes and principles of the UN Charter, respect **the sovereignty, territorial integrity** and political unity of member states and effectively maintain the inter-governmental nature of the United Nations.
