- The formation of this body is crucial as it will allow the preparation of the countries' work for the implementation of the Agreements, as mentioned by the invited experts.
- We are sure that, without a body of this nature, the cooperation between states and the implementation of this agreement will be seriously undermined. This body will ensure this agreement is not just symbolic but will effect real change in the region. Change that is desperately needed.
- The facilitation committee is a key element to show the seriousness and commitment of the countries to environmental democracy.
