



- In Loreto, 4 of the 5 committed modalities in deliverable 3 of the DCI Phase II Implementation Plan will be developed.
- 60% of the total area of non-categorized forests up to 2014 is in Loreto.
- In the region, there is the largest number of native communities per titled holder (60% of the gap).
- 4 of the 5 Indigenous Reserves to be categorized are located in Loreto (Yavarí Mirim, Yavarí Tapiche, Napo Tigre and Sierra del Divisor Occidental).
- To date the forest Zoning of Loreto has an advance of 26.83%*.

- 87% of the total area of permanent production forests to be concessioned is located in Loreto.
- 36% of the total area of existing forest concessions and that will implement the measure is located in Loreto.
- It is expected that the alliance of committed areas in Loreto will double by the next contest.
- 45% of the total surface of Native Communities is in Loreto.
- 47% of the Surface of the Natural Protected Areas (ANP for its acronym in Spanish) that will implement the mitigation measure is located in Loreto.
- 87% of the Surface of the Regional Conservation Areas (ACR for its acronym in Spanish) is in Loreto.

Measures of Commercial Plantations, Plantations with Restoration and Agroforestry Systems depend on Forest Management and Forest Zoning for their landing in regions.
